CROSSFIRE A Study of Christian Character (Part 1)

Gabriel Swaggart

ew words in history carry as much weight as those spoken by Christ in the Sermon on the Mount, yet they are often the least understood or obeyed. We live in an age of superficiality within the church, which always breeds shallowness and a lack of depth, and the reason is quite simple: much of Christianity fails to take the Word of God seriously. The Bible is our roadmap, guide, textbook, and sole authority, and it's time to rekindle our love for God's Word, open the Book of Life, and apply its contents to our lives.

As a direct result of the modern church's lack of adhering to God's Word, the church has become so intertwined with the world that distinguishing between the two has become somewhat difficult. However, as believers, we must remember that we are a part of a new community that should mirror Christ.

THE MESSAGE OF THE CROSS COMMUNITY

As we have stated many times, the message of the cross deals not only with our sin problem but also our character. It is vital to understand that if we have a genuine understanding of the cross regarding our everyday life and living, then we should realize that our character matters. How we treat people matters.

And this they are often the least understood or obeyed. We age of superficiality within the church, which a fully human life indeed but lived out under divine rule"(1)

Before delving into the Beatitudes, some fundamental principles must be clarified. To begin, all Christians are to embody these characteristics. These characteristics are not reserved for an elite few, but every single child of God is to exhibit these traits all at once, which is impossible when we rely upon our strength. To display these attributes, a person must place his faith in what Christ has done for him at Calvary's cross.

The moment we look to the finished work of Christ, the Holy Spirit will work within our lives so that we might live these traits. None of these characteristics come naturally; they are the product of God's grace and the work of the Holy Spirit within us. In other words, the Holy Spirit, acting within the framework of the cross, is required for us to exhibit these characteristics.

BLESSED ARE THE POOR IN SPIRIT

Let us now turn our attention to the first Beatitude: "Blessed are the poor in spirit: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven" (Matthew. 5:3).

"None of these characteristics come naturally; they are the product of God's grace and the work of the Holy Spirit within us."

I believe there is a problem within our message of the cross community that hasn't quite figured that part out yet, and if we do not allow the Spirit to work on our character, then we will descend into arrogance. I'm afraid that there are too many arrogant Christians who need to realize the damage they are causing to the body of Christ. Once again, we must allow the words of our Lord to penetrate our hearts so that we may be like Him, and we know that He was never arrogant in messsage or in character.

THE CHRISTIAN COUNTERCULTURE

There was a quote given by John Stott that I would like to share: "The Sermon on the Mount is the most complete delineation anywhere in the New Testament of the Christian counterculture. Here is a Christian value system, ethical standard, religious devotion, attitude to money, ambition,

There are some misconceptions about what it means to be poor in spirit. First, it does not refer to being povertystricken or lacking tangible wealth or financial resources. Poverty does not equate to spirituality, nor does it suggest that living in poverty is a means to please God. I personally do not believe that poverty pleases God or that poverty is intrinsically good. The Bible states the opposite. Take a look at Deuteronomy 28, and you will see that God's ultimate desire is to bless you in every way imaginable. The Scriptures instruct us that blessing will pursue us and overtake us; He shall command the blessings to come upon us and will make us plentiful in goods while opening unto us His good treasure and will make us the head and not the tail. There is nothing that speaks of being in abject poverty. In fact, the Word of God informs us that our God will "supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus" (Philippians

4:19). So the Bible does not teach that being poor in spirit refers to being bereft of financial resources.

So, what does it mean to be poor in spirit? It denotes a total lack of pride, self-assurance, and self-reliance. It entails admitting that we are nothing in the presence of God and having a profound realization of our absolute insignificance when confronted with the Almighty. It is an admittance that we are spiritually and morally bankrupt. We are all sinners who deserve His judgment and have nothing to offer or contribute to earn His approval. Whatever we offer regarding our self-confidence and self-assurance is useless in God's eyes; they are as filthy rags (Isaiah 64:6).

PRIDE AND SALVATION

The first Beatitude addresses humanity's fundamental issue: pride. Pride refuses to acknowledge our whole reliance on God and insists that we can save ourselves, which always leads to humiliation, death, and eternal separation from God.

Salvation, however, is reserved for those who understand their complete helplessness and place their faith in God's mercy and grace. It requires accepting the greatest gift in the world, the giving of God's only Son as a sacrifice for lost humanity. It is completely free and undeserved. Salvation cannot be earned or acquired but simply received and



accepted by faith. That might be hard for some to wrap their heads around, but it shows the love of God toward us. He gave His Son as a ransom for many, and if anyone comes humbly and recognizes his or her need for a Savior, then He will gladly accept them into His family. As C. H. Spurgeon posited, we must sink in ourselves before we can rise to the kingdom. (2)

ife often presents us with twists and turns that reveal a divine purpose, shaping our path in extraordinary ways. Such is the inspiring story of Jerry and Barbara Roach, whose resolute faith and dedication to ministry have touched countless lives. From revival meetings to pastoring churches across the Unites States, this dynamic couple has built a legacy rooted in love, music, and service to God.

A Foundation of Faith and Music

Living a Dream: Singing with The Lefevres

Barbara's journey with The LeFevres marked a transformative chapter in Barbara's life, opening doors to even greater opportunities that showcased her remarkable talent and passion for Gospel music.

In 1972, at age 21, Barbara became a member of the famous LeFevre Ouartet as the soprano vocalist for the Atlanta, Georgia based group. For a young lady aspiring to have a career in Gospel music, this was a dream come true. It was with The LeFevres that Barbara made her first appearance at Gospel music's largest annual event, the National Quartet Convention. The group also performed at a huge, prestigious anniversary event in Atlanta where many high-profile celebrities were in attendance. Barbara recalls, "Some of the performers

included Ray Stevens, Burt Parks, and others. We sang with a forty-piece orchestra before thousands of people. It was an awesome celebration and an amazing experience."

invited to perform with The Blackwood Singers, one of the

most prestigious Gospel groups of their era. Sharing the stage with such celebrated musicians elevated her career to new heights, cementing her reputation as a gifted vocalist and dedicated servant of God.

These experiences laid the foundation for her next bold step. She, along with Jan Aughenbaugh, from Kenney, Illinois, formed the group, The Emeralds. With this venture, Barbara embraced not only the spotlight but also the leadership role of guiding a group dedicated to spreading the Gospel through music.

While her professional achievements continued to soar, filling her days with travel, performances, and heartfelt ministry, Barbara remained unaware of the profound and lifechanging encounter awaiting her just around the corner. It was an encounter that would forever alter the course of her life, bringing a depth of love and partnership she had never anticipated and setting the stage for a shared ministry that would impact countless lives.

The Unlikely Beginning of a Lifelong Partnership

In 1980, Barbara met Jerry Roach, a businessman from a large, non-religious family. Their first meeting was far from Following her time with The LeFevres, Barbara was romantic Jerry admits his initial reaction to her singing was, "Sit on it!" Barbara laughs at the memory, but that moment

> marked the beginning of something extraordinary.

Jerry's life at the time was filled with questions and a deep sense of unfulfillment: "I was 36 years old, miserable, and searching for purpose," he confesses. Barbara, seeing his potential and need for faith, gave him her Bible, which was a gift to her from her father. This simple act of kindness became the catalyst for Jerry's spiritual awakening. "I read Ephesians 2:8-9, and it struck me that it's all about a relationship with Jesus Christ through grace by faith," Jerry explains.

This realization transformed his life, filling him with peace and joy he had never known. Overwhelmed with gratitude, Jerry shared his newfound faith with Barbara. "She did some shouting!" he recalls with a smile.

Building a Life Together

Barbara and Jerry's whirlwind romance led to their marriage in December 1980. By February 1981, they were ministering together. At first, Jerry played a supporting role, humorously referring to himself as the "chauffeur and gopher." But as time went on, he became an active participant in their ministry, sharing his testimony and even attempting to sing. "She says I'm tone-deaf, but I still try!" Jerry jokes.

Their marriage became a partnership in every sense of the word. Together, they embarked on a journey of pastoring churches and evangelizing, conducting revivals, and hosting crusades and camp meetings across the country.

Answering the Call to Preach


For Jerry, the call to preach was gradual but undeniable. "One day, God told me to 'Preach the Word," he says. His first sermon led to profound spiritual breakthroughs, including the transformation of a pastor and the salvation of his mother, whom he later baptized.

The couple has since pastored five churches in Tennessee and North Carolina. Their ministry has also become a family affair, with their talented daughter, Becca, and grandchildren contributing through music and other forms of service.

Barbara's love for music extended beyond performance to mentoring children. Over 40 years, she directed seven children's choirs, instilling in young hearts a love for Gospel music and worship. Her latest project, The Celebration Kids, has received widespread appreciation and is even featured on Christian Voice Radio.

In 2010, Jerry embarked on a new chapter of ministry by writing a monthly column titled 'A Preacher's Perspective' for the widely respected Christian Voice Magazine. This platform became a powerful outlet for him to share his heartfelt insights, profound reflections, and spiritual wisdom with a much broader audience. Their favorite chorus, *Goodness of God*, perfectly encapsulates their journey of faith:


All my life You have been faithful, All my life You have been so, so good. With every breath that I am able, I will sing of the goodness of God.


Leaving a Lasting Impact





"I know God never makes a mistake, and all things that He allows has a purpose.





Public Voting Opens for 13th Annual We Love Christian Music Awards



The We Love Christian Music Awards, now in their 13th year, have officially announced their nominees, showcasing the brightest talents in Christian music. Forrest Frank leads with an impressive 7 nominations, followed closely by Brandon Heath, Terrian, and We Are Messengers, each earning 5 nominations. Other artists like CeCe Winans, Jordan Feliz, and Hulvey received 4 nominations, highlighting a diverse array of impactful music in the past year.

In a testament to its continued commitment to amplifying grassroots artistry, this year's We Love Awards celebrate a record number of independent artists among the nominees. A total of 74 artists have been nominated across 22 categories, including 31 independent artists - representing 42% of all nominees and setting a new record in the award's history. This unique feature sets the awards apart, providing a platform where emerging and established artists share the spotlight, reflecting the full spectrum of creativity within Christian music.

Public voting is now open through January 24, 2025, at nrt.cc/WLA13Vote, allowing fans to have their voices heard in celebrating these incredible artists and their work. The minute we begin to sense envy or jealousy within us or an urge to be offended, we need to make a decision to put our feelings aside and say, "I am not offended."

If we don't do this - and instead just stuff it down inside of us - little things become giants in our lives. Then before we know it, we're angry, bitter, resentful people...going to





he best mix and biggest variety of Christian music from yesterday and today." This slogan aptly describes what Christian Voice Radio is really all about. The station, which launched January 1, 2018, was designed for listeners who have a diverse pallet for multiple genres and styles of Christian music. This month, Christian Voice Radio celebrates seven successful years of broadcasting the Gospel.

In recognition of the station's 7th anniversary, we caught up with station owner and manager, John Lanier. He shares a bit of interesting background, the station's evolution to becoming one of the top Christian music stations, and what the station currently offers listeners.

Those who are familiar with John know he spent more than thirty years as a touring Christian recording artist. Many also know him as the co-founder and Executive Editor of Christian Voice Magazine. But few know that his professional music career began in radio. He mentions, "It's amazing how God will sometimes bring us full circle, but it seems that is what He did with me. After I started touring with groups in the late 1980s, I never dreamed I'd be back in the radio business decades later! But it has been a phenomenal journey!"

Shortly after graduating high school in 1983, John was hired as a DJ for the night shift at WSSA 1570 AM, a small Gospel station in Morrow, Georgia (a metro area of Atlanta). Two years later, he began working as a production assistant at WVFJ 93.3 "The Joy" FM, a 100,000-watt Contemporary Christian music station then based in Manchester, Georgia

Those who are familiar with John know he spent more (now located in Atlanta). He later became a popular on-air a thirty years as a touring Christian recording artist. Many personality for the station.

In 1989, he joined Southern Gospel group, Naomi & the Segos as the tenor vocalist. A few years later, he helped form the male trio, Tony Gore & Majesty. In late 1996, John stepped out to pursue an evangelistic solo ministry.

Although health issues brought his ministry to a halt beginning in 2022, John shares, "I am healing and recovering well from multiple treatments and surgeries, including triple by-pass open heart surgery in February of 2024. I feel great, and as God continues to restore my health, I pray He will make a way for me to hit the road once again - hopefully, this year - singing and preaching the Gospel. I believe with all my heart that God still has more for me to do for His glory."

Although he misses the life of a singing evangelist, he does continue to keep up with his friends and supporters on Facebook. He explains, "I'm so thankful for the internet, as it has provided a way for me to maintain an online fellowship with so many I sang and ministered to. Occasionally, when I can, I go live on Facebook. So, I invite everyone to check my page and join us for some great fun, fellowship, and encouragement." (www.facebook.com/JohnLanierM inistries)

Through all the previous years of traveling and recent years of overseeing a magazine publication, John says his passion and interest

actively seeking any possible opportunity to somehow get involved in radio once again. After much prayer and research, I launched Christian Voice Radio on January 1, 2018."

He adds, "Randall Wilds, CEO and founder of Wilds & Associates, partnered with me for this endeavor. So, the station was launched as a conglomerate of Wilds & Associates."

Randall remarks, "John has done an awesome job of building this station. As I've watched it grow, it's plain to see how God has blessed our efforts. I'm proud of what it has become, and I look forward to continued growth."

Christian Voice Radio is a commercially supported internet station, streaming live 24/7. There are several reasons why John chose this form of media over terrestrial radio, with the greatest reason being the potential audience reach.

According to a report recently published by Statista, the reach of online radio in the United States has increased sharply in the last decade, with 68 percent of the U.S. population having listened to online radio in the past month compared to 34 percent ten years previously. Weekly online radio consumption among U.S. listeners has also increased, growing from 12 percent in 2007 to more than 62 percent in 2024.

massive, with the average user spending well over 16 hours per week using these services. Incidentally, the impressive reach and usage time of these services provides companies, ministries, and other organizations with increased advertising possibilities and user engagement opportunities.

As part of the LIVE365 radio network, Christian Voice Radio is broadcast in the United Kingdom, Canada and, of course, the United States. The station can be accessed on Roku, on the web, and via the free Christian Voice Radio app for both IOS and Android.

As would be evident, John loves Gospel music everything from Southern and Country Gospel to Inspirational Brant is the spokesperson for

and Contemporary Christian. He also enjoys anointed preaching. This variety is reflected in Christian Voice Radio's daily programming. So far, this format has been met with success as listeners indicate they enjoy the variety. John states the mission for Christian Voice Radio is to "entertain, inspire, AND inform" listeners.

Christian Voice Radio is approximately 95% music and 5% talk programming. The station plays a variety of Christian music, from Southern Gospel to Light Contemporary, from today's hits to timeless classics. Music is generally played in "sweeps" by genre to create a smooth transition from one to another, thereby creating a pleasant listening experience. But rest assured, there is something for everyone. Well, almost everyone. John mentions, "We don't rap, bang our heads, or scream."

In fact, the music featured on Christian Voice in radio broadcasting never faded. "By mid-2017, I began Radio is "hand-picked" and very carefully curated to maintain a strict policy of "excellence in broadcasting." Furthermore, as the founder and manager of the station, John says he feels responsible and accountable for how the name and the Gospel of Jesus Christ is represented by the music and other programming offered on Christian Voice Radio. (Yeah, he takes it seriously.) The talk programming on Christian Voice Radio features Biblical teaching and preaching, and news from a Christian perspective.

As previously noted, variety is a key element that attracts thousands of listeners from all over the Unted States and abroad every week. But, John explains, "Radio personalities are certainly vital to the overall energy and atmosphere of a radio station. DJs and/or radio show hosts turn mundane playlists into entertaining, engaging, and uplifting experiences. Generally, listeners look forward to tuning in to enjoy part of their day with their favorite DJ(s)."

A Life Rooted in Transformation

Brandon's childhood set the stage for a remarkable life of faith. Raised by his grandparents in a non-Christian home, Brandon's life took a pivotal turn in 1987 when his third-grade teacher, Mrs. Thompson, extended an invitation that would change everything. "She invited me to church with her son Aaron," Brandon recalls.

"I went a few times, and then my grandparents started taking me. They didn't want me going through the discipleship process at church alone, they wanted to ensure I wasn't learning anything unusual. It was through this process that not only I but also my sister and my grandparents became Christians."

Brandon describes the transformation in his grandparents as one of the greatest blessings of his life. His grandfather, a veteran of World War II, Korea, and Vietnam, became an incredible role model. "Seeing their lives change was inspiring. It solidified my faith and gave me the foundation I needed to grow spiritually."

At just twelve years old, Brandon began leading music at his home church. This marked the beginning of a lifelong journey of faith and music, intertwined in a way that would shape his destiny.

The Power of Music

Music has always held a special and transformative place in Brandon's life, shaping him in ways that words alone cannot fully capture. From an early age, it became more than just a form of entertainment, it was a language of emotion, connection, and meaning. For Brandon, family is at the core of everything he does. He met his wife, Karen, in 1998 while studying at East Texas Baptist University. They married in 2000 and have since built a life centered on faith and music. Their two children, Caleb and Caylin, are following in their father's footsteps, each excelling in their ways.

"Caleb is nineteen and studying music with an emphasis on worship at Dallas Baptist University," Brandon says proudly. "Caylin, who just turned fifteen, is a freshman at Ennis High School. She's excelling in volleyball and music, and I'm so thankful to be her dad."

The Hixson family is deeply involved in the ministry at Tabernacle Baptist Church. "Karen helps run the cameras during services and occasionally sings with the worship team," Brandon explains. "Serving together as a family is one of the greatest joys of my life."

A New Album with a Powerful Message

A rising star in Contemporary Christian music, Brandon has captured hearts with #1 hits like *When I Finally Make It Home, Autumn Fall,* and *The World Is Your Stage.* His latest album, "Room With A View," showcases eight new songs celebrating his faith, family, and friendships. Among them is the touching track, *Fifteen*, a tribute to his daughter Caylin on her 15th birthday. "It's a special song for a remarkable young lady," Brandon says. "I wanted to give her something meaningful that she could carry with her forever."

This album also tackles challenging themes such as suicide, depression, and abortion. "I wrote, produced, and sang all the tracks myself," he says. "These are tough topics, but they're important to address. I wanted to create an album that speaks to people where they are and offers them hope."

Critics have praised the album as a "stellar addition to Contemporary Christian music," with Jason Reeves noting, "Hixson is more than a musician. He's a storyteller and an inspiration."

With his soulful voice, masterful songwriting, and the rich tones of his saxophone, Hixson continues to elevate Contemporary Christian music, creating songs that linger in the soul long after they've been heard.

Philippians 4:13 is Brandon's life verse: "I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me" He says this verse has been a guiding light through every challenge an triumph. That verse has been my anchor," he reflects. "It reminds me that with God, anything is possible."

A Preacher's Perspective

Preachers. Go Preach!

"...in the last days perilous (dangerous, difficult) times shall come." (2 Timothy3:1)

"...evil men and seducers shall wax worse and worse, deceiving, and being deceived." (2 Timothy 3:13)

Does that not describe these days in which we live? There are evil forces taking over and destroying our once Christian nation. Among our nation's leaders there are those "having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof..." (2 Timothy 3:5)

We as a nation are rapidly spiraling down that path to depravity and destruction described in Romans 1. What can we do? In 2 Timothy 4:2, Paul said "Preach the word." In

Romans 1, Paul said, "I am ready to preach the gospel...For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to everyone that believeth...." (Romans 1:15, 16) Jesus said, "God ye into all the world, and preach the gospel..." (Mark 16:15) "...repentance and remission of sins should be preached in His Name among all nations..." Are we preaching the word? Recent Barna surveys indicate "Less than 10% of sermons preached in

Barna's survey also showed "57% of regular church goers say they have never had a religious experience that changed their life." Also, "69% of churchgoers believe that everyone will go to Heaven." "52% of all Christians believe that non-Christian faiths can lead to eternal life."

Jesus declared, "I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father but by me." (John 14:6)

How did we get so far from the truth? I look back to another survey by Redbook Magazine of ministerial students

in 1961 which showed 56% rejected the virgin birth of Jesus. 54% rejected His bodily resurrection. 98% rejected His personal return to this earth. In 1984, 1/3 of professing Christians said Jesus didn't rise from the dead and ¼ of them said that Jesus Christ committed sin. Today 44% believe Jesus sinned. I hear of pastors who are preaching such blasphemy. Some are saying that faith in Jesus Christ is not necessary.

Read the Bible! "....Faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God." (Romans 10:17) "All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness." (2 **Timothy 3:16)**

> "Preach word...all the scripture..." I once had a conversation with a pastor who told me that in 30 plus years of ministry, he had never once preached about hell. My response to such is" why?" Jesus preached about hell more than anyone else in the Bible. Jesus came to die for our sins that we might not end up in Hell, but live with Him forever in Heaven.






Musk's New Montessori School: 'The wave of the future'

The world's wealthiest man has gotten a permit to open Ad Astra (Latin for "to the stars") in Bastrop County, about 40 minutes outside of Austin, Texas. The prekindergarten Montessori school will reportedly teach children to sweep, draw, and explore.

This opening is said to be paving the way for the billionaire to build out his STEM-focused plans for K-12 schools and a college in The Lone Star State.

STEM learning is a student-centered approach to teaching that integrates the subjects of science, technology, engineering, and mathematics. The Montessori method of education involves children's natural interests and activities rather than formal teaching methods.

Jeane Allen, founder and CEO of the Center for Education Reform, says successful education does not look the same for everyone; it is tailored and personalized and gives students the opportunity to explore, develop, and more. "It's not a surprise that Elon Musk would want to bring his innovative and entrepreneurial skills to education," she tells AFN. "He's been incredibly outspoken about the limitations of the U.S. education system and failure."

She says conventional K-12 education played very little role in Musk's success. "He's talked about ... how he was the square peg in a round hole," Allen notes. "He developed lots of skills because he was always learning on his own. If you look at the most successful education organizations, schools, [and] alternatives out there, they do precisely what Elon Musk is planning to do."

She calls that "an amazing development" and says parents should have the opportunity to decide between having their kids sit behind a desk and listen to social indoctrination – or more engaging, thoughtful, and interactive learning methods.

In her experience, Allen says most parents "actually want their kids to learn how to read, how to speak and communicate;" they want to know about their country, about people around them, how things happen, and be set up for success.

Ad Astra, she says, is "the wave of the future" and the kind of school that everyone should welcome and embrace.

Pro-lifer Hopes for Return of 'Commonsense Protections'

Though he isn't ruling out the possibility, President-elect Donald Trump says he will not restrict the abortion pills.

When NBC's "Meet the Press" host pointed out that "more than half of abortions in this country are medication abortions" and asked if he will restrict the availability of abortion pills when he returns to office, Trump replied, "I'll probably stay with exactly what I've been saying for the last two years, and the answer is no."

He did not, however, commit to that, saying things change. "I do not like putting myself in a position like that," he told the host. "Things do change, but I do not think it's going to change."

Carol Tobias, president of the National Right to Life Committee (NRLC), says her organization would like to see the abortion pill severely restricted, but she does not know whether that will happen.

"What I am hoping is that the president will be willing to go back to the law that was in effect when he was POTUS, which were much stricter regulations on the pill from the Food and Drug Administration (FDA)," she tells AFN.

Under those restrictions, women had to see a doctor and find out for sure that they were pregnant – and also undergo some kind of physical exam to check for an ectopic pregnancy – before getting an abortion pill prescription. After taking the pills, she had to return to the doctor to make sure that the abortion was completed and that the unborn child's remains had been expelled from the uterus.

If not, there could be severe consequences like hemorrhaging, sepsis, and worse. "We've seen women die in this country because they did not get proper medical care after taking the abortion pill,"

Tobias laments. "My hope, and what I think we can see happen, is that this new administration will at least require the FDA to put these commonsense protections for women back in place."

Canada's 'Soft War' Continues

A Christian educator and traditional values activist in Canada says Prime Minister Justin Trudeau is fueling the "explosion of Jew-hate" there.

The Free Press recently published the results of its extensive investigation into the alarming growth of antisemitism north of the border, showing a 670% increase in antisemitic incidents in Canada that began within weeks of the Hamas terrorist attack on Israel on October 7, 2023.

In Toronto, for example, Nazi swastikas were plastered over a poster of one of the Jewish hostages, and a window was shattered at one of the city's synagogues.

Dr. Charles McVety, president of Canada Christian College, says Jews are afraid for their safety, and the government is not helping. "This is something we face every day," he accounts. "It's really a soft war against both Jews and Christians."

In his view, Trudeau has only made things worse. "Our prime minister, he chimes in and he says that he will agree with the International Court and arrest Netanyahu," McVety relays. "This just fuels the antisemites. It fuels the Hamas flagwaving supporters. They are emboldened, and it has to stop."

Meanwhile, as Fox News reported in October, Justin Trudeau is facing calls for his resignation and perhaps his toughest challenge yet as the Canadian prime minister. A year out from the election, a CBC News poll found that the Conservative Party, led by Pierre Poilievre, held a 20-point lead over Trudeau's Liberals.

McVety believes the election of a Conservative government would make all the difference.

Texas Pastor: Trump ready and raring to go

One of Donald Trump's earliest evangelical backers from his first campaign

already sees the president-elect applying "lessons learned" as he approaches his second four-year term.

Only weeks away from his second term in the White House, Donald J. Trump seems more focused and a bit less volatile than the first time around. That's according to a pastor who was one of Trump's spiritual advisors in his first term.

In January 2017, Donald Trump blew into Washington like the proverbial "bull in a china shop," intent on cleaning up the town and kicking the "Deep State" to the curb. But his every move was met with resistance from the political establishment entrenched in Congress ... and – by his own admission – he was too new to Washington to know who to trust.

Dr. Robert Jeffress, senior pastor of First Baptist Dallas, says this time around Trump is ready. "I think he is just as intent on fulfilling his agenda as he's ever been," Jeffress tells AFN. "But after the experience he's had in the Oval Office, I think he has probably learned some things that he is going to put into practice."

The Southern Baptist pastor recalls that Trump's 2016 campaign included an evangelical board of advisors, which was disbanded after he won. Jeffress, however, was one of several evangelicals who continued to have the president's ear and provided spiritual counsel when requested.

Jeffress shares that he still talks to President-elect Trump – and stands ready to advise if called on again. "There is no official 'board of evangelicals for White House consulting' – it's more informal ... and I have talked to him recently. He's in great spirits," he adds.

The evangelical pastor is especially pleased with some of Trump's Cabinet picks, with one in particular hitting the mark. "Who could be better as ambassador to Israel than Governor [Mike] Huckabee?" he wonders. "Governor Huckabee understands the geopolitical reasons that America should support Israel, but he also is cognizant of the biblical basis for supporting Israel."

Last month, Time magazine announced that Trump is its 2024 Person of the Year. He was honored in the same fashion by Time in 2016 when he was first elected to the White House.

Biden Admin Spent \$267 Million to Censor Critics

On its way out the door, the Biden administration is being ripped for spending hundreds of millions of dollars on a mission to fight "misinformation" during the COVID-19 pandemic, which was really an attempt to silence and censor critics.

Thanks to an extensive report by Open the Books, a government watchdog, the public has learned the one-term Biden administration was furiously trying to counter skepticism and opposition to the controversial vaccine, to forced mask wearing, and even the origin of the virus in China.

During the Trump term, the federal government was distributing approximately \$6 million to counter what it called "misinformation" at the time. Then there was an "explosion of cash" when the pandemic hit, and approximately \$267 million was spent over three years, from 2021 to 2024, the report states.

Where did those millions of dollars go? The biggest chunk of money (\$185 million) went to the Department of Health and Human Services, followed by the National Science Foundation (\$65 million), with the Department of State coming in third with a meager \$12 million.

According to HHS, the definition of "misinformation" is "information that is false, inaccurate, or misleading according to the best available evidence at the time."

For many, that definition summarizes the "trust the science" motto that was often repeated by the government and the media during the pandemic. It also mirrors the apologies that belatedly came afterward, such as masking children and the six-foot rule, which were often blamed on the "best available evidence" that was known at the time.

Curtis Houck, of the Media Research Center, read the Open the Books report. What stood out to him, he tells AFN, is that our own taxpayers' funds were used to censor social media comments our own government decided were inappropriate to share.

The chief co-conspirator behind that censorship was HHS, the recipient of the biggest block of money. It distributed that money to the Health Science Center at the University of Pennsylvania (\$2.3 million);

the University of Texas (\$2.1 million); and Michigan State University, \$348,000.

All three public universities used the HHS grant to study "misinformation" online. At the University of Texas, it researched an algorithm to detect and "mitigate the spread" of COVID-19 "misinformation." The research at the University of Pennsylvania was even more specific: It investigated how COVID-19 "misinformation" on social media influences black and rural communities.

"A lot of these smaller government agencies, that may not be as familiar to the American people," Houck says, "are absolute wastelands, apocalyptic wastelands, cosmic black holes, of taxpayer dollars."

Even though the pandemic is behind us, the report points out the "misinformation" label is still being used against critics.

After Hurricane Helene hit, FEMA has used the "misinformation" label twice to falsely claim disaster victims are not still living in tents, and also to falsely claim its own aid workers did not avoid the homes of Trump-supporting disaster victims.

In another stark example, Open the Book pointed out MSNBC host Jen Psaki recently demanded a government crackdown on social media. Because there is no "accountability" on social media, and many people get their news from it, that is why Donald Trump was able to defeat Kamala Harris, she argued.

"Laws have to change," Psaki told a podcast. "I don't even know the entire answer to it but that seems to me to be a core issue."

Psaki, who was the truth-spinning press secretary for Joe Biden, also defended the federal government's crackdown on social media during the pandemic. "We're flagging problematic posts for Facebook that spread disinformation," she boasted to White House reporters in 2021.

Psaki made her post-election comments on the "Next Question" podcast, hosted by journalist Katie Couric, who herself famously got caught deceptively editing an interview with gun owners that made them appear dumb and uninformed.

Summarizing the Open Book report, Houck says it proves the Biden administration and its left-wing allies have "disgust" for a large portion of the American public.

n June 24, 2022, the Supreme Court of the United States overturned Roe v. Wade, the landmark 1973 ruling that secured a person's "right" to an abortion. This means that individual states are now able to decide their own abortion laws. As a result, many states have severely restricted abortion access while others have banned access altogether. This ruling, known as the Dobbs decision, is considered a major victory and an answer to prayer by many pro-lifers.

But the fight to end abortion is far from over. We want to make abortion unthinkable in each and every state. We want legislators to recognize the sanctity of human life innately as they make laws regarding women's health and abortion. We want better education. We want truth. We choose LIFE.

Regardless of what the liberal, left-wing media have led many to believe, at least nine states currently have no restrictions based on how far along a woman is in her pregnancy. I repeat, NO RESTRICTIONS. Let that sink in. Many have added amendments enshrining the right to abortion in their state constitutions.

Then, there's the "abortion pill" - the common name for using two different medicines to end a pregnancy. As of June 2024, fourteen states have near-total bans on mifepristone. The other 36 states and Washington, DC, provide some form of legal access to the abortion medication. Make no mistake, this medication is NOT a form of birth control. To be clear, birth control pills *prevent* a pregnancy. Abortion pills *end* an existing pregnancy. This method of abortion rose to high demand after the Dobbs ruling.

Thus, the number of women getting abortions in the U.S. actually went up in the first three months of 2024 compared with before the Supreme Court overturned Roe v Wade, according to data from several sources. A major reason for the increase is that some Democratic-controlled states enacted laws to protect doctors who use telemedicine to see patients in places that have abortion bans, according to the quarterly #WeCount report for the Society of Family Planning, which supports abortion access.

It seems that a mother's womb is the most dangerous place in the world. People across the globe are destroying unborn babies in record numbers. Worldometers, the real-time statistics website, has been tracking abortion for a number of years and comparing those deaths to, for example, heart disease and cancer. The conclusion is abortion is the leading cause of death across the planet. Yes, you read that right. Abortion has surpassed heart disease and cancer to become the leading cause of death around the world.

The data on abortions displayed on the Worldometer's counter is based on the latest estimates on worldwide abortions published by various sources, including the World Health Organization (WHO). According to WHO, every year in the world there are around 73 million induced abortions. This corresponds to approximately 200,000 abortions per day.

Pro-life leader Carol Tobias, of the National Right to Life Committee, says one reason for that statistic is a lack of respect for human life. "We are seeing that in our country, in our communities, and worldwide," she says. "Human life just isn't precious anymore and we don't take those extra steps to protect it, and certainly not for preborn children when we can't really see them."

Bryan Kemper, who heads up Stand True youth outreach, admits he was surprised over the general reaction to his recent

post on X of a woman holding a sign that shows the real feet of an eight-week-old pre-born baby girl who was aborted. "She'll never learn to walk," the sign reads.

The post has garnered more than 16 million views, and most of the responses either deny its truthfulness or personally attack Kemper for pointing out that "abortion is an act of violence. Deadly violence."

"They are so calloused, and... the wool is pulled over their eyes so much about what abortion is," he laments. "When you show the truth, they get angry; they get upset. They don't want the world to see the truth about what's happening to precious little baby boys and girls every single day in abortion mills."

The pro-lifer recognizes, though, that denying the truth and attacking the messenger are favored tactics of the Left. Still,

they are not enough to sway him. "I don't care what anyone says to me. I don't care if you put a gun to my head. I will never denounce Jesus, and I will never back off my pro-life position."

Pointing out that the lives of preborn babies are at stake, he says it is time for more pro-life people to take a stand for children in the womb, regardless of how the opposition reacts.

I wholeheartedly agree with Bryan - abortion IS a deadly act of violence. I will not mince words, abortion is murder, plain and simple. And don't let them fool you, most proabortionists know this even though they would never admit it. Because, in all too many cases, abortion is the answer for "inconvenient" pregnancies. I said what I said. It's also a multi-million-dollar industry.

They use words like "fetus" and phrases like "a clump of cells" to detract from the reality that it's a human life. But, unborn doesn't mean unalive!

And don't buy the 'rape/incest' and 'risk of the mother to lose her life' arguments often cited by pro-abortionists. The facts: According to the Lozier Institute, among other sources, the LEAST common reasons for abortion are rape and incest at only 0.4% and risk to the mother's life at only 0.3%. In contrast, 95.9% of abortions are chosen due to "inconvenience."

One physician who performed abortions in the past reveals, "This is the absolute truth. I did 1200 abortions, first and second trimester. One was for rape, two were for incest. About nine or ten were for genetic defects like Trisomy 21 (down syndrome), and all the rest of them were healthy moms and healthy kids. People believe what they want to believe, and they don't want to believe that, but that is the truth."

He adds, "I killed 1200 kids. How can you make up for even one of them? I can't. So, now I do everything I can to save as many as I can."

Abortion is demonic. Satan would kill God if he could, but he can't. So, he kills babies because he knows it wounds the heart of the Father and causes chaos. Abortion is not new, the practice goes way back to ancient times. It is a sacrament of Satan.

One of the most notorious aspects of Baal worship was child sacrifice. 

Today, Janelle is 46 years old, married to the love of her life, and together they have raised a healthy son who is now a flourishing young adult.



Honey Apple Pork Loin in a Crockpot

(Tweaked from internet recipe)

2+ lb. pork loin
2 apples (sliced and divided)
1 onion (sliced)
1/4 butter (sliced)
1 teaspoon salt
1/2 teaspoon pepper
1/2 teaspoon cinnamon
1/3 cup honey
1 teaspoon dried thyme



Cut 1" slits on the top of the pork loin about 1" apart. Place a piece of sliced apple in the slits. Set aside.

Add onion and remaining apples in the bottom of the crockpot. Add slices of butter.

Place pork loin on top of butter. Sprinkle the loin with salt pepper, cinnamon and thyme. Drizzle honey over the top.

Cover and cook on LOW for 6 hours without opening the lid during the cooking time. When the cooking time is done, remove the pork to a platter and let rest for at least 5 minutes. Slice and serve.

Fried Potato Cakes

1 cup mashed potatoes (leftover and cold)
1/4 cup flour
1 large egg (lightly beaten)
Tony Chachere's (to taste)
1/4 cup onion (chopped)
Enough oil for frying

Add potatoes, Tony's, and chopped onion until combined.

Sprinkle flour and lightly combine. Don't overwork the flour or it will become sticky.

Heat oil in cast iron skillet.

Form balls from 1/3 cup potato mixture. Flatten to about 1/4" and gently place patties in oil.

Cook 2 minutes per side or until golden. Drain on paper towel. Don't over crowd skillet.




Broiled Tilapia


